

EUCALYPTUS REMOVAL
LTCWD FIRE SAFETY INITIATIVE
DETAILS AND HOW TO APPLY:

'10 - '11
Funding at
\$3,500/home

The Incentive:

The District will fund up to \$3,500 for the clean up or removal of Eucalyptus trees for any resident. By clean up, we're referring to the removal of woody Eucalyptus debris under the tree(s) and the removal of any lower branches which may act as "ladder fuels" to ignite the rest of the tree should a wild fire approach.

Timing:

Funds are for work performed from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011 or until available funds are exhausted.

Restrictions:

The district has allocated enough funds for 8 homes. In general, funding will be on a first come first served basis.

How to apply:

Call the program's coordinator, Charlie Krenz, at 851-8085 and check to see if funds are available. If they are, register your name, and you'll have 2 months to get the work performed and send in your paper work. If you are unable to get the work done in this time the next person on the waiting list becomes eligible and will be notified.

Next select a contractor and have the work performed. We encourage you to obtain multiple bids and have provided a list of contractors that have received positive recommendations by neighbors in the area. We don't guarantee their work. You are not required to use these contractors.

Please take before and after photos and send them to the District at Firesafety@LTCWD.org (or call us so that we can stop by for a look 851-8085). Then, send us a copy of the contractor's itemized invoice that clearly identifies the Eucalyptus work and the amount you are applying for. We'll then process a reimbursement check.
