

# SOD KILLED TREE REMOVAL

## LTCWD FIRE SAFETY INITIATIVE

### DETAILS AND HOW TO APPLY:

LTCWD will evenly split the first \$2,000 expended by District residents on the removal oak trees killed by SOD.

#### **Timing:**

Funds are for work performed up to June 30, 2010 or until available funds are exhausted.

#### **Restrictions:**

Funds are only available for the removal of **dead** Oak trees that are displaying or have displayed SOD symptoms. (photos of trees removed after July 1, 2009 but prior to the program's re-announcement can serve as proof) The district has allocated enough funds for just 15 homes. In general, funding will be on a first come first served basis.

#### **How to apply:**

Call the Program's coordinator, Charles Krenz, at 851-8085 and check to see if funds are available. If they are, register your name, and you'll have 2 months to get the work performed and send in your paper work. If you are unable to get the work done in this time the next person on the waiting list becomes eligible and will be notified. Please also at this time arrange for an appointment so that a district representative can visit your tree(s) to verify SOD Symptoms.

Then select a contractor and have the work performed. We encourage you to obtain multiple bids and have provided a list of contractors that have received almost all positive recommendations by neighbors in the area. We don't guarantee their work. You are not required to use these contractors. Finally, send us a copy of the contractor's itemized invoice that clearly identifies the SOD kill removal work and the amount you are applying for. We'll then process a reimbursement check. Please send the paper documents to:
