

SHAKE ROOF REPLACEMENT INCENTIVE

LTCWD FIRE SAFETY INITIATIVE

DETAILS AND HOW TO APPLY:

The Incentive:

The District will split the cost on the first \$4,000 expended on the replacement of your wood shake roof with a roof made of flame retardant materials. (\$2,000 max per household) Because there are relatively few homes with wood shake roofs remaining in the neighborhood, the budget for this fund has been set at \$20,000, enough for 10 homes.

Timing:

Funds are available to homes re-roofed from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011 or until available funds are exhausted.

Restrictions:

Roof must conform to ASTM standard Class A or any higher classification... most roofs, so long as they are not wood shake, will pass this standard. Ask your roofer for more information.

How to apply:

Call the program's coordinator, Charlie Krenz, at 851-8085 and check to see if funds are available. If they are, register your name, and you'll have 3 months to get the work performed and send in your paper work. If you can't get the work done in this time we'll have to give the next person on any waiting list a try. Once the work is performed, send us a photo of the home, a copy of the contractor's invoice and we'll process a reimbursement check. Please send the documents to:
